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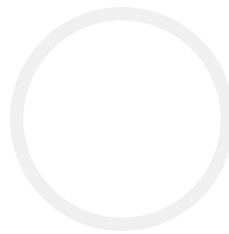
## Hereditary Nasal Parakeratosis, HNPK

## What can you do?

If your dog is affected, we recommend the following actions:

**1**

Talk to your vet about your dog's HNPk result so you can plan appropriate care and monitoring.

**2**

Keep your dog's nose moisturized with a gentle, dog-safe balm to prevent cracking and irritation. Avoid harsh rubbing or wiping, as the skin is sensitive and can easily become sore.

**3**

If you notice bleeding, infection, or significant discomfort, contact your vet for further treatment options.
